The mission of Erie Events is to provide worldclass convention facilities and entertainment venues throughout the region to visitors and residents, their families and friends. Erie Events strives to present a diverse selection of performing arts and sporting events enjoyable not just to residents of our own community, but also to meeting and convention visitors, travelers and vacationers.

Erie Events employs nearly 600 part-time and over 50 full-time staff members, operating the Erie Insurance Arena, Warner Theatre, UPMC Park, and the Bayfront Convention Center.

The operation of these facilities is supported exclusively by the hotel occupancy tax. The Sheraton Erie Bayfront Hotel and the Courtyard Erie Bayfront Hotel, both owned by Erie Events, each generate more hotel occupancy tax than any other hotel in Erie County. Erie Events hotels produce sufficient operating revenue to satisfy all of their financial obligations. Erie residents provide no local tax dollars to support Erie Events or its facilities.

The Erie County Convention Center Authority (Erie Events) Board of Directors is made up of 11 members who each serve four-year terms without compensation. The Mayor of the City of Erie appoints two members, the Governor of Pennsylvania appoints two members, and each member of Erie County Council appoints one member. The appointment process assures the Board represents all of Erie County.



ERIE INSURANCE ARENA

The Erie Insurance Arena continues to be the premiere sports and entertainment venue in the tri-state region. Home to the Erie Otters for the past 27 years, it hosts a wide range of events that include national touring concerts, family shows and special events. With 13 modern, fully-equipped suites that can accommodate 22 guests and a Club Level that offers the perfect view complete with food and beverage service, the arena seats 9,000 for concerts and 6,700 for hockey games.

In 2022, the **Erie Otters** returned to the ice with a season highlighted by player recognitions and community initiatives. Carey Terrance was named to the 2023 CHL/NHL Top Prospects Game, Malcolm Spence was the top scoring OHL rookie and Spencer Sova and Nolan Lalonde both represented Erie in the IIHF U18 World Championships. In the community, the Otters raised \$75,000 for local charities and created several new initiatives that included the first-ever Imagination Library Night with the United Way and the first-ever Children's Grief Awareness Night with Highmark Caring Place. The Otters also donated 2,000 pairs of socks to the Erie City Mission through their annual Sock Toss.

In addition to OHL hockey, the Erie Insurance Arena hosted several major sports tournaments: **The Sarah Backstrom Memorial Girls Hockey Tournament** (4 days), **MLK Cup Hockey Tournament** (4 days), **Keystone State Wrestling Championships** (3 days) and **Champion Cheer National Cheer & Dance Championships** (2 days).

With a combined attendance of over 30,000 people, these events generated over \$5 million dollars in economic impact to the Erie area.

Family events and concert highlights for 2022 included **Breaking**Benjamin with Seether, Starset, and Lacey Sturm, WWE Saturday
Night's Main Event and 6 performances of Disney On Ice Into The
Magic. The Arena also hosted several college and high school hockey
games and graduations.













WARNER THEATRE

Erie's crown jewel is shining brighter than ever. The Warner Theatre's \$36 million renovation, expansion and restoration project was completed in January of 2022. The Warner Theatre is now a state-of-the-art performing arts center that can accommodate larger, national touring shows and artists.

Over 14,000 square feet of new back stage support space was added that included dressing rooms, production offices, loading bays, wardrobe and laundry facilities. An elegant Rehearsal Hall, sized to replicate the Warner stage, was built to accommodate orchestra and chorus rehearsals, receptions, small performances and other events.

The **Erie Philharmonic** made a triumphant return to the Warner Theatre in 2022. With eight sold out performances in 18 shows, the orchestra performed for more than 35,000 patrons. In addition, the Philharmonic held four youth performances and introduced classical music to over 5,000 local school children.

Broadway in Erie also returned in 2022 with the largest production ever on the Warner Theatre stage, **Disney's Aladdin**. Hundreds of cast and crew members along with over 11 tractor trailers of set equipment and wardrobe filled the Theatre for five performances. This production would not have been possible without the recent renovations and expansion!

The Warner also hosted numerous local dance recitals, allowing local performers to take Erie's premier stage. Additionally, the **Lake Erie Ballet** presented three performances of Erie's favorite holiday tradition,

The Nutcracker.

Since the Grand Re-Opening of the Warner, these notable, national touring artists have performed at the theatre: Alice Cooper, Alton Brown, "Weird Al" Yankovic, Daughtry, Foreigner, ZZ Top, Cole Swindell, Trace Adkins, Kenny G. and Zach Williams.

UPMC PARK

UPMC Park has been home to the Erie SeaWolves since 1995. Since that time, over five million patrons have passed through the gates to enjoy high-quality professional baseball. The ballpark features six 20-guest luxury suites, a 40-person super suite, picnic areas in right and left field, three primary concession stands and a Party Deck with 20-person boxes for a semi-private, outdoor experience.

The 2022 season was filled with accolades and accomplishments for the **Erie SeaWolves**. Winning the first playoff series in team history in front of record crowds, the SeaWolves were crowned the **2022 Eastern League Southwest Division Champs**. Two new single-season franchise records were set with strikeouts (1,373) and homeruns (175). On the player side, Pitcher Reese Olson had the most strikeouts (168) by a pitcher in a SeaWolves season and he also received the Rawlings Gold Glove Award. Quincy Nieporte and Parker Meadows were Eastern League All-Stars and Nieporte was named the Eastern League MVP. On the leadership side, President Greg Coleman was named the 2022 Erie Times-News Sportsman Of The Year through his innovation and hard work.

In addition to Double-A baseball, UPMC Park hosted the City vs. County
All Star Game, several college and high school games, Movies Nights at
the Ballpark and a Play Ball Weekend, a program that encourages young
people to learn and participate in baseball. The SeaWolves 2022 promotional
calendar featured the most expansive slate of events and premium giveaways
in team history. Fans enjoyed 10 Zambelli fireworks nights, Two-Buck
Thursdays, Spencer Torkelson collectables, Casey Mize Gnomes, Snow
Wolves winter caps and many other fan favorites. In addition, children 12 and
under had the opportunity to run the bases after every home game.

The Erie SeaWolves annually contribute more than \$250,000 in goods and services to support charitable efforts in the greater Erie region. Community initiatives included: Youth Baseball Sponsorships, Chace Numata Scholarship, Sensory Friendly Day at the Ballpark, Strike Out Poverty, C. Wolf's Healthy Challenge and Tickets for Veterans.

BAYFRONT CONVENTION CENTER


