I am pleased to once again present Erie Events Annual Community Report. I would like to personally thank the people of Erie County and beyond for supporting and attending the events in our venues. We pride ourselves in providing a diverse array of activities for our community, but our success is ultimately driven by the fans, attendees and concertgoers that grace our doorways. We are proud to report that 2024 was a banner year for the venues we operate. Events at Erie Insurance Arena generated a 40% improvement

over the previous year, the Bayfront Convention Center once again saw record-setting activity and the Warner Theatre surpassed \$2 Million in event activity for the first time ever. The Erie Seawolves followed their historic first-ever Eastern League Championship with an unbelievable repeat season and the Erie Otters returned to playoff contention. 2024, however, ended on a sad note as we mourned the passing of Jim Waters, long-time owner of the Erie Otters. As we enter a new year, we are focused on supporting and keeping the Otters in Erie as we know Jim would insist.

We are proud of the role we play in boosting our local economy through the attraction of large conventions and creating lifetime memories for everyone whatever your passion may be. Our organization now employs nearly 70 full-time associates and 800 part-time staff members. We operate the Erie Insurance Arena, Warner Theatre, Bayfront Convention Center and UPMC Park as well as the two hotels owned by Erie Events: Sheraton Erie Bayfront and Courtyard Erie Bayfront by Marriott. All our venues are supported exclusively by operating revenue and hotel occupancy tax. Erie residents enjoy our venues and provide no local tax dollars to support Erie Events or any of our facilities.

In the proceeding pages, you will read more about the venues we manage along with some of the highlights from this past year. In 2024, we hosted nearly 685,000 fans and attendees across our facilities. There are many exciting things happening at Erie Events and we hope you join us in celebrating our successes. I hope you find our report encouraging and informative and I look forward to seeing you at one of our venues in 2025.

- Facility Maintenance: Added netting inside Erie Insurance Arena and extended netting inside UPMC Ballpark for enhanced fan safety. Replaced the baseball field to maintain our ballpark to MLB standards and to ensure the safety of the players.
- Emergency Procedures: Staff were well-trained in emergency response protocols, so every individual knows how to respond swiftly and effectively.
- Security Measures: Additional security has been added at each event to maintain a calm and safe atmosphere.

As we look to the future, we're thrilled about the exciting developments on the horizon. We will aim to further improve the entertainment experience for our community by expanding our programming and exploring new ways to reach larger a bigger and more diverse audiences.

However, none of this will would be possible without the continued support of our wonderful community. We are grateful for your involvement. The appointment process assures the Board represents all of Erie County.





## **ERIE INSURANCE ARENA**

The Erie Insurance Arena, a versatile multi-purpose facility, continues to be the premiere sports and entertainment venue in the tri-state region. Its central location makes it an integral part of Erie's downtown, drawing both locals and visitors to a variety of events throughout the year. The modern arena features a Club Level with 13 fully equipped suites that can accommodate 22 guests.

Last year, the Erie Insurance Arena hosted a schedule of events filled with performances from national touring artists and family friendly shows to professional sports tournaments and community gatherings. A special highlight was the return of the rock sensation **Trans-Siberian Orchestra** for two sold out performances – 9,000 fans enjoyed the elaborate show featuring stunning visual effects. Comedian **Bert Kreischer** entertained the crowd with his contagious enthusiasm and **Breaking Benjamin**, **Daughtry**, **Brantley Gilbert**, **Struggle Jennings** and **Sexyy Red** gave concertgoers a night of musical memories.

Family shows were stronger than ever at the Arena last year, offering something for everyone: **Paw Patrol Live, Disney On Ice, Harlem Globetrotters, WWE Saturday Night's Main Event** and making their first appearance in Erie was **Motorcycle Ice Racing** and **Hot Wheels Monster Trucks Live**.

The Erie Insurance Arena has been home to the Erie Otters for the past 30 years. Last season the Otters advanced to the playoffs, ending their playoff drought and played three postseason games in front of 12,300 cheering fans.

## WARNER THEATRE

In 2024, the Warner Theatre continued to serve as a central hub for cultural and community events, attracting visitors from around the tri-state area. The theater's blend of historical significance, architectural beauty, and lively programming makes it one of Erie's most cherished venues. The Warner first opened in 1931 and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

From live entertainment, concerts and corporate events to film screenings, weddings, dance recitals and graduations, the Warner hosted a diverse schedule of events filled with a rich lineup of musical performances. **Chicago**, **John Mellencamp**, **Dancing With The Stars** and **Theo Von** attracted record crowds with sold-out performances. Rock and roll shows were well represented with electrifying performances from **REO Speedwagon**, **The Guess Who**, **Collective Soul**, **Theory Of A Deadman**, **Godsmack**, **Kenny Wayne Shepherd** and **Cinderalla's Tom Kiefer Band**.

Our historic theatre has been home to Broadway In Erie for the past 44 years. Continuing to feature an eclectic lineup of Broadway titles, family shows and cutting-edge performances, Broadway In Erie presented 12 performances last year to nearly 15,000 patrons. The blockbuster shows included **Hairspray**, **Annie**, **STOMP**, **Shrek**, **Dear Evan Hansen** and **Elf The Musical**.

The Erie Philharmonic, the largest tenant in the Warner Theatre, presented their annual Symphonic and Pops Series that featured 14 spectacular performances. The orchestra also hosted several open rehearsals, post-concert receptions and fundraisers at the theatre.

For the first time, the Erie County Bar Association held their annual **Law Day** celebration at the Warner Theatre. The event featured guest speaker and author Doris Kearns Goodwin and Steve Scully.

## **UPMC PARK**

UPMC Park serves as the home field for the Erie SeaWolves, the Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. The ballpark opened in 1995 as Jerry Uht Park and was renamed UPMC Park in 2019 due to a naming rights partnership with the University of Pittsburgh Medical Center.

The stadium is a fan-friendly venue that offers great sightlines to watch a game in an intimate atmosphere. The ballpark features six 20-guest luxury suites, a 40-person super suite, picnic areas in right and left field, three primary concession stands and a Party Deck with 20-person boxes for a semi-private, outdoor experience. In addition, the ballpark features the most unique gathering space in downtown Erie. Located on the top level of the left-field building, the UPMC Park Stadium Club is a 175-person space overlooking the playing field.

In the 2024 season, the Erie SeaWolves played a total of 138 games, comprising 69 home games at UPMC Park. The ballpark also hosted numerous events besides baseball games, including charity walks, corporate outings, fireworks displays, movie nights and other community events.
